Masses Resume

The faithful remain dispensed from the Obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation until further notice.

- ◆ Weekday Masses Monday—Friday, 8:30 AM
- ◆ Confession, Saturday 3:00—3:30 PM
- ◆ Saturday Vigil Mass, 4:00 PM
- ◆ Sunday Masses 8:30 & 10:30 AM
- ◆ You **must** call the rectory to reserve your Mass time as space is limited, (815-727-9378). If you are not on the list for the Mass, you will not be allowed in.

Attendees Must

All those who enter the Church properly must:

- ◆ Wear a mask
- ◆ Remain 6 feet apart
- ◆ Allow attendants to sanitize your hands
- ◆ Follow posted signage
- ◆ Listen to staff and usher instructions

Important Notes

The Church will be sanitized after each Liturgy.

By following these strict guidelines from the diocese, we will be allowed to continue celebrating Mass. Thank you for understanding and for adhering to these guidelines.

Holy Communion

- ◆ Ushers will release the faithful by pew to receive Communion
- ◆ Eucharistic Ministers will wear face shields
- ◆ Communion may only be received by hand
- ◆ Masks must be worn until the faithful step away from the minister and can pull their mask down to consume the host
