General Information

Religious Education registration has begun for the 2022-2023 school year. The packet consists of the registration form (one per family), as well as a copy of the Parental Agreement Form. The agreement clearly explains what we expect of you in order for your child to benefit from our program. Please read the agreement carefully and sign it. The second copy is for your records.

RE classes for 2022 – 23 will again be held on Tuesdays. We will continue with some of the procedures set in place in the last couple of years, which will be addressed at the parent meeting. The Parent Meeting is scheduled for September 13th @ 5:00 pm in Ferdinand Hall. Classes begin on Tuesday, September 20th @ 5:00 pm. **ALL STUDENTS MUST BE PRE-REGISTERED PRIOR TO THE FIRST DAY OF CLASSES.** *Parents can call the Rectory (815-727-9378) to register, registration forms can be returned to the Rectory office prior to September 13th at 416 N. Chicago St., Joliet, IL 60432, put it in the Sunday collection basket in an envelope marked "Religious Education" or handed in at the Parent Meeting on the 13th. No late registrations accepted.*

The tuition schedule is listed below. Checks should be made payable to "St. Joseph Parish". Tuition can be paid in full or we will accept monthly payments **as long as the balance is paid in full by December 13, 2022.** **Payment can also be paid online.** *Any family not paid in full by December 13, 2022, needs to call the rectory or meet with Mrs. Gimbel to discuss payment.*

Sacramental Fees: \$30 for those children receiving the Sacraments of Reconciliation/Holy Communion.
